REGISTRATION BEGINS

March 1, 2019 - Returning Campers Only

March 15, 2019 - New Campers & Returning Campers

Space is limited in camp, so register early! Check social media for updates on registration.

FEES

Fees include all supplies, meals, 1 camp t-shirt, 1 camp ID and trips.

You may register for the entire summer or register for individual sessions.

\$50 registration fee due at time of application

+

\$150 Each Session

OR

\$300 for Full 6 weeks (2 Sessions)

Total for one 3-week session: \$200

Total for 6 weeks: \$350

MONEY ORDER OR CHECK

Applicants who are accepted are registered and a place is held for them in a specific encampment. If they do not attend, they are still registered and they are not entitled to a refund of the registration fee. If an applicant is not accepted, he/she is not registered and any paid fees will be refunded.

ACCEPTANCE

Accepted Campers will receive an email to notify them of acceptance and information on payment and meetings.

FAMILY DISCOUNTS

Discounts apply to siblings attending camp only!
